## Enrolling your Child

- Camp Sessions are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment is limited so please register early.

### Enrollment Packets 2010

- Please return completed forms to the Boroughs YMCA.
- An enrollment packet including camp registration and medical forms can be found in this brochure. Additional forms are available at the Boroughs YMCA or on our website [www.ymcaofcm.org](http://www.ymcaofcm.org).
- Campers will not be registered until a completed enrollment packet, including immunization records, along with a *\$50 non-refundable deposit* per camp session is received. Please complete one set of enrollment forms for each child.

### Payment Deadlines

- Camp balance must be paid in full by 5/30/10 for Camp Sessions 1—5 and by 6/30/10 for Camp Sessions 6—10.
- Extended care payment in full is required at the time of registration.

### Dismissals/Cancellations

- \$50 deposit is non-refundable.
- In case of dismissal or voluntary withdrawal, there will be no refund of fees after the above payment dates unless the camper is unable to attend due to prolonged illness.
- Transfers between sessions must be made at least two weeks prior to session start date. All transfers/refunds require Director approval and will be charged a transfer fee of \$10 per camper per session.

### Membership Requirements

- Your child's membership must be valid during the entire session for which they are registering to receive the member rate for that session. Otherwise, the non-member rate will apply.
