Frequently Asked Questions

Who can attend a School's Out Program?

School's Out Programs are open to children in kindergarten through sixth grade. Advance registration is required for all School's Out Programs.

Where are programs located?

School's Out Sites operate at the following locations:

- **Gates Lane School**
- **Kid's Learning Center (YMCA building at 41 Piedmont St.)**
- **YMCA Site (at Murray Ave.)**

The YMCA offers van transportation, supervised walk or School Bus transportation from the following schools:

There is an additional \$5/week/child fee for van transportation.

When are programs open?

Schools Out programs operate from school dismissal to 6:00pm on school days.

During school vacations and many holidays, a full day program (8:00am to 6:00pm) at the YMCA Site (at Murray Ave.) is available to School's Out participants (separate registration is required). During the summer, the Central Branch YMCA operates a ten-week day camp (separate registration required).

What activities are offered?

School's Out programs offer a variety of enrichment, recreational, and educational activities such as cooking, arts and crafts, drama, science, computers, games, and sports.

Homework help is offered on a daily basis. An emphasis is placed on building life and social skills. School's Out participants also have opportunities to interact with their community through field and community service projects.

What standards/regulations do School's Out programs follow?

School's Out Programs are licensed by the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) and follow all regulations for School-Age Child Care. Our programs are also guided by YMCA of USA standards for quality children.

What is the cost to attend a School's Out Program?

Registered for 5 days/week: \$ 93.00/week	4 days/week: \$78.00/week
3 days/week: \$ 63.00/week	2 day/week: \$46.00/week

Financial Assistance is available; apply when you register. We also accept Vouchers and have EEC slots.
