

## **Camp Blanchard**

### ***Frequently Asked Questions***

#### **Who can attend Camp Blanchard?**

Camp Blanchard has programs for children who are entering grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup>. Advance registration is required for all sessions, see YMCA staff contact information below.

#### **Where is the Camp located?**

Our facility is conveniently located on Manchaug Road in Sutton, Mass., a 20-minute drive from Worcester. Camp Blanchard consists of 35 acres of woodlands, fields, and waterfront on Lake Manchaug, with convenient access to I-395 and Route 146.

#### **Is transportation provided?**

We provide transportation from the Central Community Branch YMCA at 766 Main Street in Worcester, and from Auburn High School.

#### **When is the Camp in session?**

Camp Blanchard operates in one-week sessions from June 21<sup>st</sup> through August 27<sup>th</sup>. Camp is open from 8:00am – 5:30 pm. For an additional fee, Before-Camp Care is available from 7:30 – 8:00 am and After-Camp Care is available from 5:30 – 6:00 pm (for those campers using transportation from the Central Branch YMCA.)

#### **What activities are offered?**

- Each week is a celebration of a different theme (i.e., Wacky Week, Carnival Chaos, Time Warp and many more). Also, each week in Sports we will focus on the fundamentals of a different favorite American sport (i.e., baseball, football, soccer, and more);
- The Camp Blanchard program offers a diverse curriculum of activities. The five main activity focuses are Swimming (including swim lessons), Sports, Living Arts, Outdoor Adventures, and brand new this summer, Team Extreme, an activity for campers to enjoy archery, boating and cooperative games.

#### **What standards/regulations does Camp Blanchard follow?**

Camp Blanchard is licensed by the Department of Public Health and is guided by YMCA of the USA Day Camping Quality Standards.

#### **What is the cost to attend Camp Blanchard?**

*Full Day: \$225/YMCA members, \$250/potential members (per week)*

*Before Care: \$25 a week*

*After Care: \$25 a week*
